

Arthonia punctella







Identification: This lichenicolous fungus produces black, rounded apothecia without margins on the thallus of *Diplotomma alboatrum*. The asci contain eight two-celled ascospores. The ascospores are initially colourless but soon become brown and warted.

Similar species: No other fungi are known that produce apothecia on this host.

Habitat: On thallus of *Diplotomma alboatrum* on rocks and walls.

Distribution: Suspected of being common but difficult to spot.
